

#### **Practical details**

We aim to allocate one hour per participant, with 20-30 minutes dedicated to presenting the research topic/proposal and 30-40 minutes reserved for questions, feedback, and discussion. The exact timing will be finalised when the number of participants has been confirmed.

Each participant will have an individual session with only the panel.
